JUNIOR BOER GOAT SHOW

- Place: Arkansas State Fairgrounds, 2600 Howard Street, Little Rock, Arkansas 72206.

- 1) ABGA rules shall govern the Junior Boer Goat Show.
  - 2) The show is open to Arkansas students only, who are bona fide members of an FFA Chapter or 4-H Club. Exhibitors must be at least 9 years of age by the opening day of the fair.
  - 3) Each exhibitor will be limited to two entries per class.
  - 4) All animals are to be shown by the exhibitor entering them unless unavoidable circumstances prevent the exhibitor from being present, in which case another junior as defined in rule 2 may show the animal. Any "unavoidable circumstance" must be deemed as such by show management and the exhibition of the animal by another Junior Exhibitor must be approved prior to the beginning of the class in which the animal is entered.
  - 5) The entry fee for Junior Boer goats is \$5.00 per goat. Entry fees are to be paid to the Arkansas State Fair. Entries must be postmarked by August 25th , 2003. A late fee of \$5.00 per goat will be added to the entry fee for entries postmarked after this date. Late entries must be received by September 9th.
  - 6) Junior Boer goats can arrive anytime after noon on Thursday October 9th. They must be in place by 11:00 AM on Sunday October 12th. Junior Boer goats will be released after the show on Monday October 13th
  - 7) All animals must be checked in with the show superintendent or an assistant.
  - 8) This Show is Junior ABGA sanctioned for Percentage Does, Full Blood/Purebred Does and Full Blood/Purebred Bucks. All Junior Boer goats must be registered in the herdbook of a recognized association 30 days prior to the opening date of the show. Recognized associations include ABGA, International Boer Goat Association, USBGA, and the Canadian Boer Goat Association. The original registration certificate is required. Animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor and must have been owned by the exhibitor by July 15, 2003. Animals can not be registered in a farm name or as joint ownership with an adult. Animals must have registration numbers at time of entry. No pending registrations will be accepted.
  - 7) A registration certificate will be required for all Junior Boer goats. The certificates must be checked by the show superintendent or an assistant before an animal can be shown.
  - 8) Percentage Boer Doe Classes are for does 50% to 87% Boer. Fullblood Boer Classes are 15/16 (93.7%) and higher for does and 31/32 (96.8%) and higher for bucks.
  - 9) Animals shown in group classes must also be shown in individual classes.
  - 10) Substitutions are permitted within the breed. There is a \$10.00 charge for each substitution.
  - 11) Base date for figuring age is the date of the show.
  - 12) All goats must exhibit well-healed tattoos and be correctly tattooed. Check tattoos at time of application. Boer goats may have other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent identification, the exhibitor is responsible for providing a microchip reader.
  - 13) Exhibitors must provide their own bedding and feed. Bedding and feed can be purchased on the grounds.
  - 14) Goats may be examined on grounds by fair personnel, veterinarians, or state-federal personnel. Goats showing evidence of abscesses will not be allowed to enter the barn or show and may be released by fair officials, veterinarians, or state-federal personnel. Goats showing evidence of other disease may also be released. Goats coming from out of state must have a valid certificate of veterinary inspection with identification of each animal.

- 15) Any Boer goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from all of the breeding classes. Artificial coloring will be a disqualification. Any Boer doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded and can not prove a current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
- 16) An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 90 days of the show.
- 17) Entry forms may be reproduced and will be accepted.
